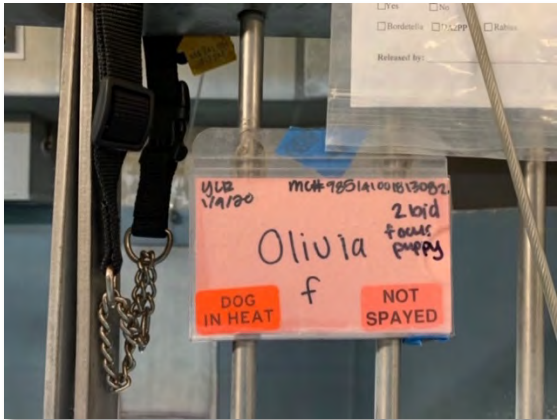

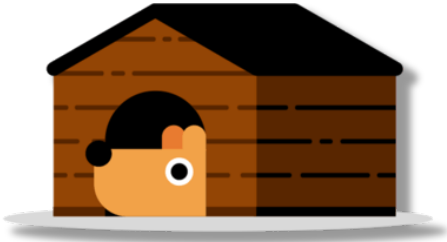
Well, here I am, up at Guide Dogs of America. Can't a girl get a little privacy? Yeesh.
